3 V 3 Basketball Rules and Regulations

1. Who can Play?

The Tournament is open to anyone registered and competing in the Corporate Challenge. You may only be allowed to play for one team in your bracket

2. Number of Players

Each team may consist of a maximum of 5 players and a minimum of 3 players. Only 3 players are allowed on the court at a time. For all co-ed divisions one players of the opposite sex must be on the court at all times.

3. Equipment

No players will be allowed to wear a guard, cast, hard brace, or other potentially dangerous equipment on his/her elbow, wrist, hand, finger, or forearm. The referees have the right to deem any equipment dangerous or unnecessary and their word is final.

4. Ball Size

An intermediate size basketball will be used for all co-ed games, while a full-sized basketball will be used for all other games

5. Length of Game

Each game will be 20 minutes long consisting of 2 halves each being 10 minutes. The winner will be determined by who has the most points at the end of the 20 minutes.

***in an event the game is tied after 20 minutes there will be a brief 2-minute overtime period to decide the winner. IF the game is still tied after the 2 minutes, the game will be decided by free throws (best of 3).

6. Change of Possession

There will be no "Make it Take it" Rule. Possession will change after every score and free throw. The only exception being flagrant or technical fouls.

7. <u>Time-Outs</u>

Each team will have 1 timeout per game. The time out will be 1 minute long and does not carry over to other games if not used. Should the game go to overtime an additional 30 second time out will be permitted for each team.

8. <u>Substitutions</u>

Substitutions can be made anytime there is a dead ball or stop in play. Substitutes will be called onto the court by referees only.
