Part 1. Ball Size

Part 2. Duration of the Game

U8<	2 - 20 minute half's

- 5 minute halftime for all games

Part 3. Scoring system

- **Standings:** Standings during group play will be determined by the following point system:
 - WIN: 3 points
 - TIE: 1 point
 - LOSS: 0 points
- **Overtime Rules:** (Playoffs only)
 - 2 - 10 minute half's (golden goal)
 - If tied after 2 overtime halves the game will be decided by Penalty Kicks
 - Refs will perform coin toss with team captains to determine who shoots first
 - Best of 5
- **Tie Breaker:** If at the end of pool play two teams are tied the following will be the deciding factors
 - **1st** : head to head
 - **2nd**: goals against
 - **3rd** : goals for

Part 4. Players Equipment

- **Uniforms:** The Visiting team’s Coach shall verify the uniform colors with the Home team’s coach, prior to the game. All field players on a team shall wear similar colored jerseys, shorts, and socks. A legible non-duplicating number on the back of each jersey is required. Players and substitutes shall not change numbers or remove their jerseys prior to the completion of the game without specific permission of the referee.
- **Shin Guards:** Shin Guards are required for all players and are to be worn during all matches, and are to be covered entirely by the players’ socks. Shin Guards are to be made of suitable material, to provide a reasonable degree of protection.
- **Coaching:** No Club official, Club member, team manager, adult supervisor, player, or spectator may enter the field of play regardless of the circumstances, unless they have been given permission by the Referee. If this is disregarded, they shall become subject to disciplinary actions by the tournament director.

Part 6. Number of Players

Part 7. Awards

- Awards will be given to the top 3 teams in each age group
 - 1st place: gold medal
 - 2nd place: silver medal
 - 3rd place: bronze medal

Part 8. Sportsmanship

- In accordance with FIFA policy, there shall be no dissent between players and/or coaches, and the referee. Questioning a referee's call is considered dissent. Coaches are responsible for the actions of their fans, and are expected to demand their support in monitoring and enforcing this policy. A player or coach who receives a red card is automatically ejected from the tournament. A player or coach who receives two yellow cards in a game is out of the game and the following game. A player or coach who receives three yellow cards during the tournament is ejected from the entire tournament
